The personal data about you

Statistical and other demographic information such as IP address is collected on an aggregate basis of all visitors to the website www.amcham.lv to identify popular areas of the website and assess how the website is being used.

Use of cookies

AmCham may use cookies on this site. Cookies are small data files stored on users' computers. This allows us to recognize repeat users and compile aggregate data for content improvements. Cookies do not damage users' computers or files. You may change your website browser settings to reject or disable cookie use.

Unless otherwise stated, we are not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such websites and their use of information. Please note that this privacy policy applies only to the personal data collected through this website.
