

OSAC Steering Committee

OUR COMMITTEES

AmCham advocacy efforts are driven by its members. Through the working groups, AmCham develops policy positions on issues impacting its members. There are three working groups focusing around the following:

- Labor force
- Healthcare
- OSAC (Overseas Security Advisory Council)

Labor force availability and talent attraction

In 2019 AmCham conducted a survey on Latvia's labor market challenges among its members and published its position "Latvia – an international career destination" highlighting the necessity to promote Latvia as a career destination and to develop skills to reduce current labor market mismatch. Among recommendations are streamlining of the immigration process for qualified labor and business visitors,

supporting regional mobility and housing with incentives to employers, investments in innovation, education and a more precise forecast for the future skills, in addition to strengthening public-private partnerships and inter-governmental cooperation.

Healthcare Working Group

AmCham re-established Healthcare working group in the beginning of 2019 with an aim to improve the quality and access of healthcare focusing on patient outcomes, which provide for longer and better lives. Currently the working group is preparing a vision along with certain pilot projects that would enable the healthcare system to become more effective and efficient.

OSAC

On April 18, 2019 the U.S. Embassy Riga in cooperation with AmCham Latvia established the Overseas Security Advisory Council (OSAC) Riga Council and elected the Steering Committee. OSAC Riga Council provides a forum promoting security cooperation between the U.S.

Embassy and the private sector in Latvia. It is co-chaired by Roberts Melbardis, AmCham Board Member and Paul Poletes, Deputy Chief of Mission at the U.S. Embassy in Latvia.

Internal Market Committee of the Economy Council at the Ministry of Economy

In addition to its working groups, AmCham is an active member of the Internal Market Committee of the Economy Council taking part in bi-monthly meetings. The purpose of the committee is to promote and develop entrepreneurial competitiveness of Latvia in the EU Internal Market for the free movement of goods and services, competition, trade, consumer and conformity assessment issues. Among issues brought up by AmCham include the shortage of labor, digitalization, impact of the tax reform on donations, insurance, GDPR and the availability of public services in English. In the committee the Chamber is represented by Zinta Jansons, Vice President and Liga Smildzina-Bertulsone, Executive Director.


