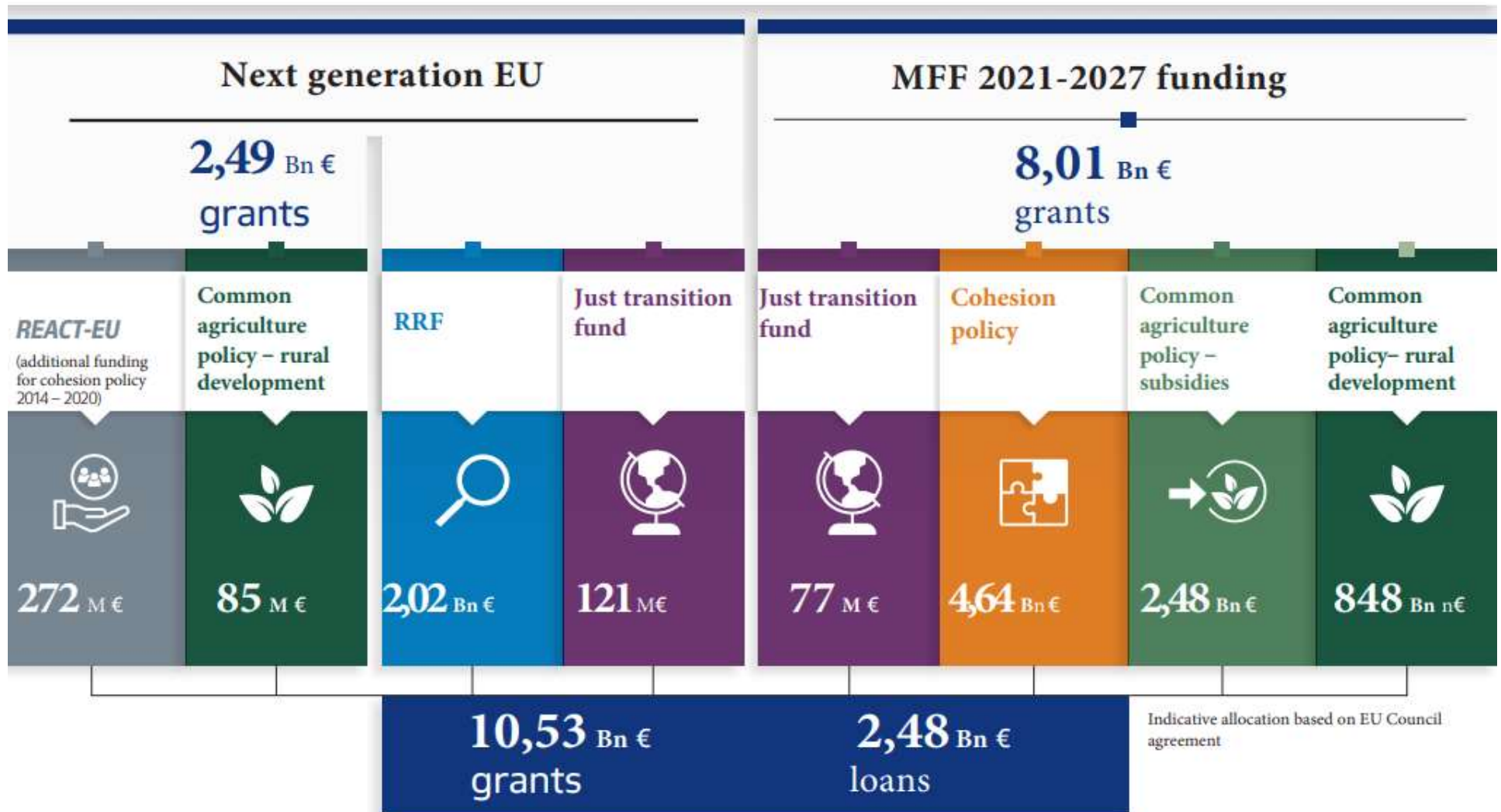

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# Initial reform proposals

Climate

- Transition to sustainable transport and renewable fuels, promoting energy efficiency in all sectors, introducing centralized crisis management center

Digital transformation

- Introducing coordination mechanisms for public sector IT system development

Health

- Healthcare network effectiveness, remuneration reform

Reducing disparities

- Administrative territorial reform (incl.school network),GMI reform

Economic transformation

- Innovation policy, Higher education governance reform (incl. optimization higher education institutions)

Rule of Law

- Public benefit organizations reform, strengthening capacity of institutions responsible for combating shadow economy and economic crimes



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# Provisional investment portfolio

Climate

- **Transport:** Riga agglomeration, *Bio*-methane, Rail Baltica
- **Energy efficiency:** buildings, industry, district heating, grid synchronization, melioration
- **Mitigation:** capacity of Fire and Rescue service

Digital transformation

- **Public services:** open data, digital platforms
- **5G network**
- **Business digitalization:** R&D, skills, digital solutions for business operations (e-bills etc.)

Health

- Hospital network effectiveness, Medical education, Long-term care, Innovation fund for service quality

Reducing disparities

- **ATR:** industrial zones, school network optimization, affordable and social housing, availability of public services

Economic transformation

- **Innovation policy:** loans and grants for enterprises, bio-economy
- **Education and skills:** governance of higher education, attracting staff, improving infrastructure

Rule of Law

- **Business environment:** customs, public benefit organizations platform
- **Combating economic crimes:** training and equipment
- **Improving governance:** regionalization, training



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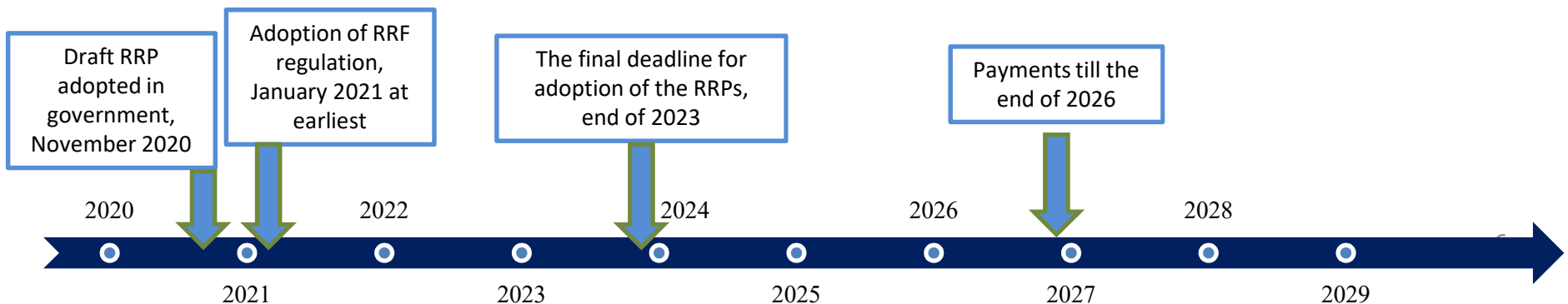
## Further Steps
